

## **Full & Part Time AmeriCorps Position**

September 12, 2016 – August 18, 2017

Join our AmeriCorps team to support elementary students in Woonsocket. Our full time and part time members partner with a K-3 classroom teacher during the school day to support the entire class then teach small groups of students using Wilson Foundations, a multisensory early literacy intervention technique. Members continue their service by developing and teaching enrichment classes in our busy after school program Monday – Thursday.

The core value of our program is delivered through a consistent presence in a child's life which is why our program values consistent attendance. Members continue to engage with students during two school vacation camps – February and April, and then finally complete their service in a summer camp.

CCF offers a six week summer camp to K-2 students to prevent the "summer slide", the concept describing academic regression over the summer months. AmeriCorps members utilize their leadership and curriculum development experience to run the camp. Members develop six weeks of curriculum teaching math, science, literature and physical education.

### **Qualifications:**

- Full Time members will serve 1700 hours of service from September 12, 2016 – August 18, 2017. Part Time members will serve 900 hours starting September 12, 2016. End date TBD
- Be at least 18 years of age, with preference given to those 55+
- Preference is also given to those candidates who have a college degree, or college coursework, in education or education-related subject.
- Be a U.S. Citizen, U.S. National, or Permanent Resident and provide documentation of citizenship.
- Complete a state criminal background check, F.B.I. background check, Attorney General BCI check, C.A.N.T.S. clearance through D.C.Y.F., and Identity and Citizenship Verification Process.
