MEMBERSHIP/PROGRAM FEE:

- A one-year CCF membership fee of \$15 per family and a \$5 activity fee per 8-week cycle/per child are required to participate in Kids' Adventure Program. **All CCF members must renew annually.** Paid CCF members of our 2019 summer camp, Camp Discovery are paid through August 2020.
- No student/family will be turned away if they cannot pay. Scholarships are available upon request. Please ask Rebbeca Davila for a scholarship form.

PROGRAM:

- At school dismissal, students will be called to the gym for attendance, circle time and fun activities. Students will go to the cafeteria receive a dinner and do homework In addition, students will be able to participate in fun learning centers. At 3:30pm, students will be dismissed to enrichment programs.
- **From 3:30-5:00pm. students will be in enrichment program. With the exception of emergencies, students should not be picked up early unless Kids' Adventure staff has already been notified by a note or phone call.**
- **Dismissal is from 5:00pm – 6:00pm from Monday-Thursday and 5:00pm on Friday. Please do not be late.** Dismissal is at the front entrance of Citizens. Please bring a valid photo ID in order to sign out your child.
- **Only those listed on the pickup list will be allowed to dismiss students. Please notify Kids' Adventure staff of any changes made to your child's registration form.**

REGISTRATION:

- All students participate in Homework Club Monday-Thursday before and after the enrichment classes. All students **MUST** do homework or read during that time.
- Please return your registration form and payment to the CCF office or mailbox at Citizens.
- Programs fill up fast, so please indicate a second choice on each day. Late registration forms are always accepted if there are spots available in a program. Programs are going to be limited to 15 participants, so please return your registration forms in a timely manner.
- On Fridays, we are offering limited programming. We will be enrolling on a first come, first served basis.

Program Descriptions:

Homework Help (Monday –Thursday) - Students will participate in homework help for 45 minutes daily. School day teachers, program staff and college students will be available to students who need help.
