The program begins the week of March 27th and ends May 25th. Kids' Adventure at Citizen's Elementary runs from 2:45pm-6:00pm, Monday through Friday.

MEMBERSHIP/PROGRAM FEE:

- A one-year membership fee of \$15 per family and a \$5 activity fee per 8-week cycle/per child are required to participate in Kids' Adventure. Scholarships are available upon request. All memberships must renew annually. Paid Members of our Summer Camp Chillin' & Skillin' are paid through August.

PROGRAM:

- At school dismissal, students are to come to the gymnasium. Students will be given dinner, participate in the enrichment programs they have signed up for, receive help in a homework club, and play at designated learning centers until dismissal.
- All students in the after-school programs are dismissed between 5:30 – 6:00pm unless there is a unique circumstance!** Please do not be late. Dismissal is at the front door of the school. The door will always remain locked so you must knock. Please bring a photo ID so we know who you are and sign your child/ren out. **NO STUDENT WILL BE DISMISSED BEFORE 5:30 unless there is an emergency.**

REGISTRATION:

- Students may register for up to **five days** of enrichment programs and homework help per week. Kids' Adventure runs from 2:45 to 6:00pm. Homework Help Club is available Monday-Thursday after the Enrichment class. **The Friday program runs until 5:00pm.** Choose **one** of the enrichment programs scheduled for each day.
- Please return your registration form and payment to the school's main office or mail or bring it to Connecting for Children & Families.
- Programs fill up fast, so please indicate a **second choice** on each day. Late registration forms are always accepted if there are spots available in a program. Programs are going to be limited to 15 participants, so please return your registration forms in a timely manner.
