MEMBERSHIP/PROGRAM FEE:

- A one-year membership fee of \$15 per family and a \$5 activity fee per 8-week cycle/per child are required to participate in Kids' Adventure. Scholarships are available upon request. **All memberships must renew annually.** Paid Members of our 2018 Summer Camp Chillin' & Skillin' are paid through August 2019.

PROGRAM:

- At 3:20pm; students will come to the cafeteria for homework club. In addition to receiving help with their homework, students will receive a dinner. Students will be also engage in learning centers during this time. At 4:00pm, students will be dismissed to enrichment programs.
- **From 4:00-5:30 students will be in enrichment program. With the exception of emergencies, students should not be picked up early unless Kids' Adventure Staff has already been notified by a note or phone call.**
- Please use the cafeteria entrance during dismissal. **Dismissal will occur between 5:30-6:00pm. Please do not be late. A fee will be charged for excessive lateness. Please have a valid photo I.D. present upon dismissal. Please notify Kids' Adventure Staff of any changes made to your child's registration form.**

REGISTRATION:

- All students participate in Homework Club Monday-Thursday before and after the enrichment classes. All students **MUST** do homework or read during that time.
- Please return your registration form and payment to the school's main office or CCF office at Coleman Elementary.
- Programs fill up fast, so please indicate a second choice on each day. Late registration forms are always accepted if there are spots available in a program. Programs are limited to 15 participants, so please return your registration forms in a timely manner.
- On Fridays we are offering limited programming. We will be enrolling on a first come first served basis.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Homework Club– Mondays-Thursdays (K-5)– Students will get help with their homework, read, and play educational games to earn homework points that can be cashed in for prizes at the end of the 8 week cycle!

Fun with Food (Mondays K-2)– Students will learn about how to eat nutritious foods and will end program making a healthy snack each week.

Girls Club (Mondays 3-5)- This program will teach girls about leadership, self esteem, and give them a safe space to be themselves! Girls will learn conflict resolution skills, be guided through discussions and do fun confidence boosting activities.

Mindful Senses (Mondays K-5)- Students can relax and unwind after a long day. They will be taught ways to manage their stress, engage in sensory play, do fun craft activities and more!

One on One Basketball (Mondays K-2)- Skilled coaches will spend each week teaching students the basics of a variety of different sports as well as how to work on a team and good sportsmanship.

Pastry Decorating (Monday 3-5)- Students can be pastry chefs in this program! Each week students will be taught how to combine art with pastry decorating.

Roger Williams Park Zoo (Mondays K-2 & Wednesdays 3-5)- Students will explore the different types of animals in the world. They will learn about animal habitats, what foods they eat and much more through fun interactive games and arts and crafts. Each week a new animal will come into the classroom.

Student Leaders (Mondays 4 & 5)– Now you can be part of team of student leaders! Elections will be held for student representatives. Help make afterschool program and your school a better place! Be a voice for you and your friends in Student Leaders!

Audubon Society (Tuesdays K-2 & Thursdays 3-5)- Discover what types of wildlife live in your neighborhood. You will investigate your schoolyard, meet live animals, play nature games, conduct experiments, and have loads of fun. If you like animals and the outdoors, this after school program is for you!

Creation Station (Tuesdays 3-5)- Do you love creating art? If so, this program is for you! Create different types of artwork using many different mediums.

Fun Fitness (Tuesdays 3-5)– Students will do exercises in fun ways and play a variety of sports.

Gamm Theater (Tuesdays K-5)– Students will learn about the art of theater. This will happen through a wide variety of theater games and activities. Students will also work on a performance that will take place at the end of cycle 2's showcase!

ENRICHMENT PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Music and Movement (Tuesdays K-2)– Get movin' and grooving' with Mr. Mike! Students will learn songs, dances and will perform a dance at showcase! Strap on your dance shoes and join music and movement.

Arts and Crafts (Wednesdays K-2)- Students will work with various art mediums each week to create different projects.

Career Explorers (Wednesdays 3-5)- Students will listen to guest speakers, do career themed activities and more to learn about different careers.

Dance (Wednesdays K-2 & Thursdays 3-5)-This program is designed to get students moving and grooving. In this class, students will learn a choreographed routine to perform at our showcase.

Reading Warriors (Wednesdays 3-5)- Students will read a new book each week and do a fun comprehension activity.

Save the Bay (Wednesdays K-2)-During this afterschool program, you can experiment what it is like to be a marine biologist. You will discover the different habitats of a New England estuary and meet some animals that call the Bay home. You'll be introduced to the smallest Bay creatures and some of the largest! Not only will you take part in fun Bay related activities, but you'll get the chance to meet and hold many live animals!

Boy Scouts (Thursdays 1-5)– This program is for boys that are looking to become role models to their peers. Students will engage in a variety of activities to help build a great self-esteem and self-confidence as well as building a better community.

ESL Club (Thursdays K-2)- This program is designed for English emerging students. Students will learn the English language through the use of fun games and activities.

Helping Hands (Thursdays 3-5)- Students can be a community hero! Students will identify a need in their community and help develop a project to make a difference!

Legos (Thursdays K-5)- Students can be engineers in this popular STEM program. Students will build catapults, cars, free standing structures and more using Legos.
