MEMBERSHIP/PROGRAM FEE:

- A **One-Year** membership fee of \$15 per family and a \$5 activity fee **per 8-week cycle/per child** are required to participate in Kids' Adventure. Scholarships are available upon request. All memberships renew annually. Paid members of our Summer Camp Chillin' & Skillin' are paid through August of the following year.

PROGRAM:

- At school dismissal, students are to come to the cafeteria. Students will be given dinner, play at learning centers, receive help during homework club, and participate in the enrichment programs they have signed up for.
- **From 4pm-5:30pm all students are in there enrichment activity. Students should not be picked up early unless Kids' Adventure staff has already been notified by note or phone call. Many times programs go to the park, if your student is at the park when you arrive you WILL NOT be able to pick them up early.**
- **Dismissal is from 5:30pm– 6pm Please do not be late. There will be a fee for excessive lateness.** Dismissal is at the side door near the teachers' parking lot. The door will always remain locked so you must knock. Please bring a photo ID so we know who you are and sign your child out.

REGISTRATION:

- Students may register for up to **four days** of enrichment programs and homework help per week. All students participate in Homework Club Monday-Thursday before and after the Enrichment classes. All students **MUST** do homework or read during that time.
- Please return your registration form and payment to the school's main office or CCF office at Coleman.
- Programs fill up fast, so please indicate a second choice on each day. Late registration forms are always accepted if there are spots available in a program. Programs are going to be limited to 15 participants, so please return your registration forms in a timely manner.

Homework Help Club

Monday-Thursday – K-5
