**PROGRAM:**

- At 3:20pm; students will come to the cafeteria for homework club. In addition to receiving help with their homework, students will receive a dinner. Students will be also engage in learning centers during this time. At 4:00pm, students will be dismissed to enrichment programs.
- **From 4:00-5:30 students will be in enrichment program. With the exception of emergencies, students should not be picked up early unless Kids' Adventure Staff has already been notified by a note or phone call.**
- Please use the cafeteria entrance during dismissal. **Dismissal will occur between 5:30-6:00pm. Please do not be late. Please have a valid photo I.D. present upon dismissal to pick up your child(ren). Please notify Kids' Adventure Staff of any changes made to your child's registration form.**

**REGISTRATION:**

- All students participate in Homework Club Monday-Thursday before and after the enrichment classes. All students **MUST** do homework or read during that time.
- Please return your registration form and payment to the school's main office or CCF office at Coleman Elementary.
- Programs fill up fast, so please indicate a second choice on each day. Late registration forms are always accepted if there are spots available in a program. Programs are limited to 15 participants, so please return your registration forms in a timely manner.
- On Fridays we are offering limited programming. We will be enrolling on a first come first served basis.

## ENRICHMENT PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

**Homework Club– Mondays-Thursdays (K-5)** – Students will receive help with their homework, read, and play educational games to earn homework points that can be redeemed for prizes at showcase! **All students are automatically enrolled in Homework Club.**

**Helping Hands (Mondays K-5)**- Students can be a community hero! Students identify a need in their community and help develop a solution to meet that need.

**One on One Basketball (Mondays K-2)**- Skilled coaches provide students with a foundation to play a variety of sports throughout the eight weeks. Sports include: dodgeball, soccer and basketball. Students learn sportsmanship and how to be part of a team.

**Literacy Leaders (Mondays K-2)**- Students can practice their literacy skills through the use of hands on activities, crafts and learning centers.

**Roger Williams Park Zoo (Mondays 3-5 & Wednesdays K-2)**- Students will explore animals from around the world. They will learn about animal habitats, what foods they eat and much more through fun interactive games and arts and crafts. Each week a new animal will come into the classroom.

**Minecraft Movie Maker (Mondays 3-5)**- Students can direct their own short, stop motion movie.

**Girls who Code (Mondays 3-5)**- Students will learn the basics of computer language and use computer sciences to find creative solutions to real world problems that are important to them!

**Chess Club (Mondays 3-5)**-Students will learn the basics of chess as well as learn social skills, problem solving skills and critical thinking skills.

**Music and Movement (Tuesdays K-2)** – Get movin’ and groovin’ with Mr. Mike! Students will learn songs, dances and will perform a dance at showcase. Strap on your dance shoes and join music and movement!

**Reading Blast (Tuesdays K-2)** - This program is designed for students who may need a little extra help with reading or just love to read! Students will read, write and play using themed games and crafts!

**Lego Engineering (Tuesday K-2 & Thursdays 3-5)**- Using Legos and their imagination, students will find creative solutions to real world problems.

**Learn Spanish (Tuesdays K-2 & Wednesdays 3-5)**- This program is designed for students who would like to learn a second language. Ms. BrendaLee will use fun games and activities to teach students how to speak Spanish!

**Girls on the Run (Tuesdays & Thursdays 3-5) - Separate Application is Required** - Girls will learn about self confidence, empowerment and will get active. Girls involved in this program will also have the opportunity to run a 5K in May.

**Junior Achievement (Tuesdays 3-5 & Fridays K-2)**- Students will learn about their communities, families and will begin to build a foundation for career exploration and financial success.
